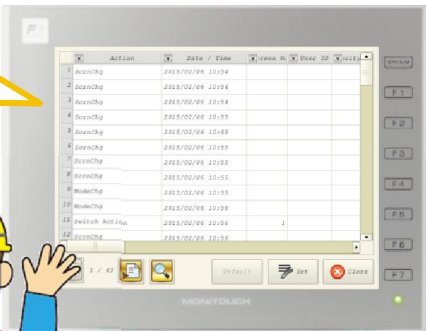

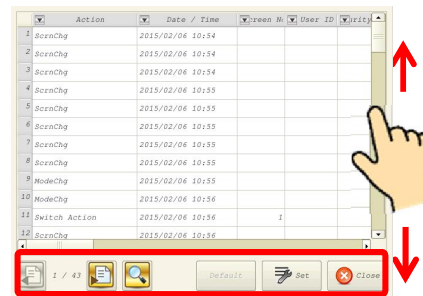
Renewed Log viewer

Simple layout enables you to operate it intuitively.

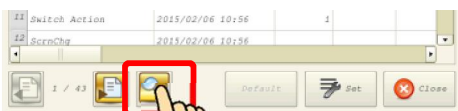


- Scroll operation
- Icons to guide you necessary settings

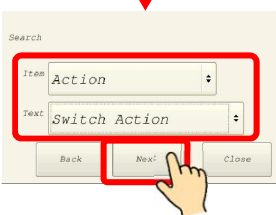
2. Search function

Specify the operation to search (e.g. switch operation) to show the result!

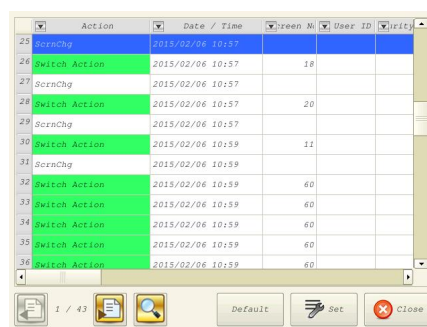
3) Search results are displayed.

< Cursor on the top row

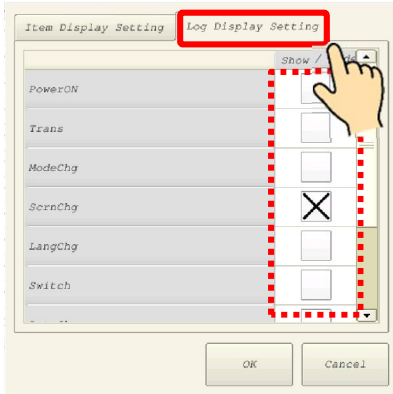
Appropriate data is highlighted in green.

You can select show/hide of each item as well as display order.



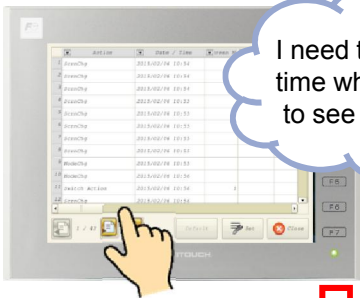

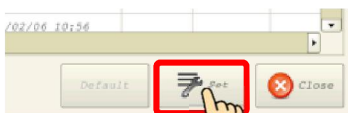

4. Changeable column order

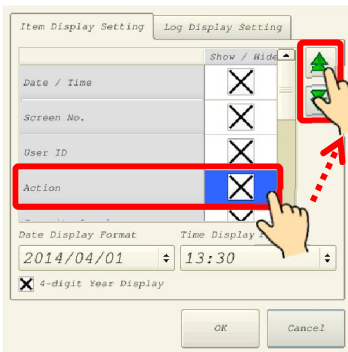


I need to scroll every
